Crufts is the biggest and greatest dog show in the world. As dogs have to qualify to enter, the boast is that this shop window offers exhibitors and spectators a chance to compete and view the best of the best. I was delighted to get my chance to judge this prestigious event and having started my judging career back in 1973 at Romford & DCS, the intervening 41 years have served as a long apprenticeship in dogdom. I have done the hard miles and served the OES breed at all levels so I welcomed this opportunity to get my hands dirty and was rewarded with an entry of 119. This is way down on the 271 that I judged at the OES Club show in 1989 and reflects the fact that we find ourselves on 'Breed Watch', vulnerable is the new buzz word, and describes the low standing we hold in the canine popularity charts of dog ownership and a reflection of the lack of registrations at the Kennel Club, now hovering around the 300 mark per annum. I attended an excellent seminar at the new Kennel Club centre in Kenilworth a few weeks back which I have reported on in the social media, and now that the Crufts judging is over I must fill in a form to reflect the state of the breed as I found it. An excellent initiative and one that I hope extends to the Breed Health reps. and a shake up in the way that Kennel Clubs interact with each other around the world. Our breed has gone global, especially in the breeding and showing of stock, we must standardise and recognise all the data we have on health issues and accept it across all borders so that we can all sing from the same hymn sheet. Well, I will be reporting on a worldwide entry as I see from the catalogue that many dogs arrived at the NEC from all parts of the globe and brought their quality with them. The entry I judged in OES was, overall, of the highest quality in type, substance and presentation. 3 dogs were grumpy and refused to be handled in depth, (they were not excluded from the ring, but overlooked for placement!), rear movement was very good, with no obvious 'cow hocks' or 'weakness' that are points on 'Breed Watch', coats, likewise, were ok overall, none were excessive in length or profuseness. Plenty needed more harshness in texture, but sadly 'Breed Watch' does not state this even though very important in a working dog, remember 'Fit for Function'!! I would also flag up the level toplines that are creeping in, even at this high level of competition. The rise to loin is a unique feature of our breed and too many are giving the impression that they have a rise via clever presentation of the body coat. The length of neck is also getting shorter, a good reach is another essential in the pasture and stuffy necks are too often found in the ring. None of these are health issues but worthy of mention and notes to flag up as I have a concern. I hope this critique gets read at the Kennel Club and around the breed clubs. We need this initiative to kick start a revival in the English National breed and I hope that health, welfare and the Breed Standards get closer to the aim of "Fit for Function". All my winners and the great majority of my entry could do a day's work. A number of owners may chuckle at the thought of their pampered pooch slogging away on the drove roads for a few weeks, but their exhibits were certainly built for it, and many fitted the bill, and may surprise us one day. Another delightful observation that I have already mentioned was that our breed has gone global and the overall quality was enhanced by many overseas entries. I know the top awards went overseas, and many other good ones stood in the line-ups, all I did was to judge the dogs that were stood in front of me on the day. If I liked them last year, then I liked them again this year. If they were great dogs last year then they were great dogs this year. I always judge on the day and started with a clean sheet and an open mind. I did weigh up the option of the flashy dog possibly winning the Group or the outstanding bitch winning my heart, my heart won, as I pleased myself and I had no right to rely on the opinion of a Group Judge later, I had to do what was best for the breed, in my opinion. I would like to thank my ring stewards, Mrs Gentleman and Mrs Hasell who kept things moving efficiently and enabled me to keep to the strict time constraints laid down by the Cruft's committee. Two minutes per dog is never enough time to do justice to a heavily coated breed or allow photos in the ring after every class, and then to allow 3 breeds to follow in the same ring. My apologies to Vic Salt for over-running by 30 minutes and delaying his judging. Thanks to all the exhibitors for your support and for taking my decisions so sportingly.
